Key capabilities

Lower cost per bit

Peering routes are priced below full transit because we are not buying them.

Shorter paths

Traffic leaves at the exchange nearest the destination rather than being carried to a transit handover.

Predictable table

A smaller, stable prefix set with clean origins, IRR filters and RPKI validation applied before it reaches you.

Published reach

Our exchange and interconnect list is public, so you can see which networks the service covers before ordering.
